There are not many private green spaces in our neighbourhood. Most of Kosovo is dirt and highly populated. Our yard however has a large green grassy area where youth can play football or sit and talk. At Fusion there is lots of time for community to be built, mama Terry serves a good meal for everyone to share, and we add some meaningful and relevant discussion. Community and lasting relationships are fostered in just this way.

While most of the young people participating in Fusion are already friends and may go to the same church, this is a fun event that lets them step away from work, school, service and other commitments to do community.
