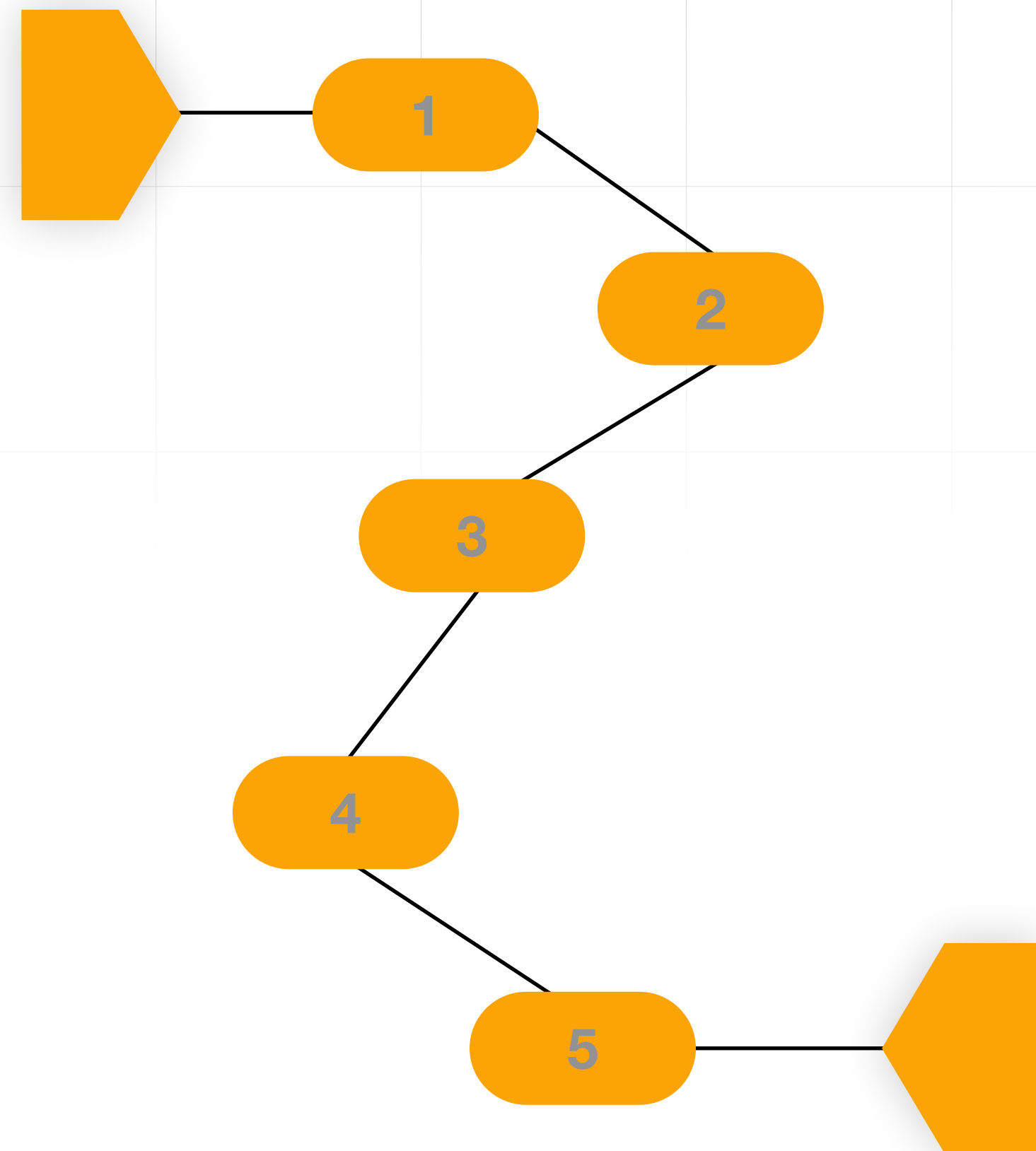

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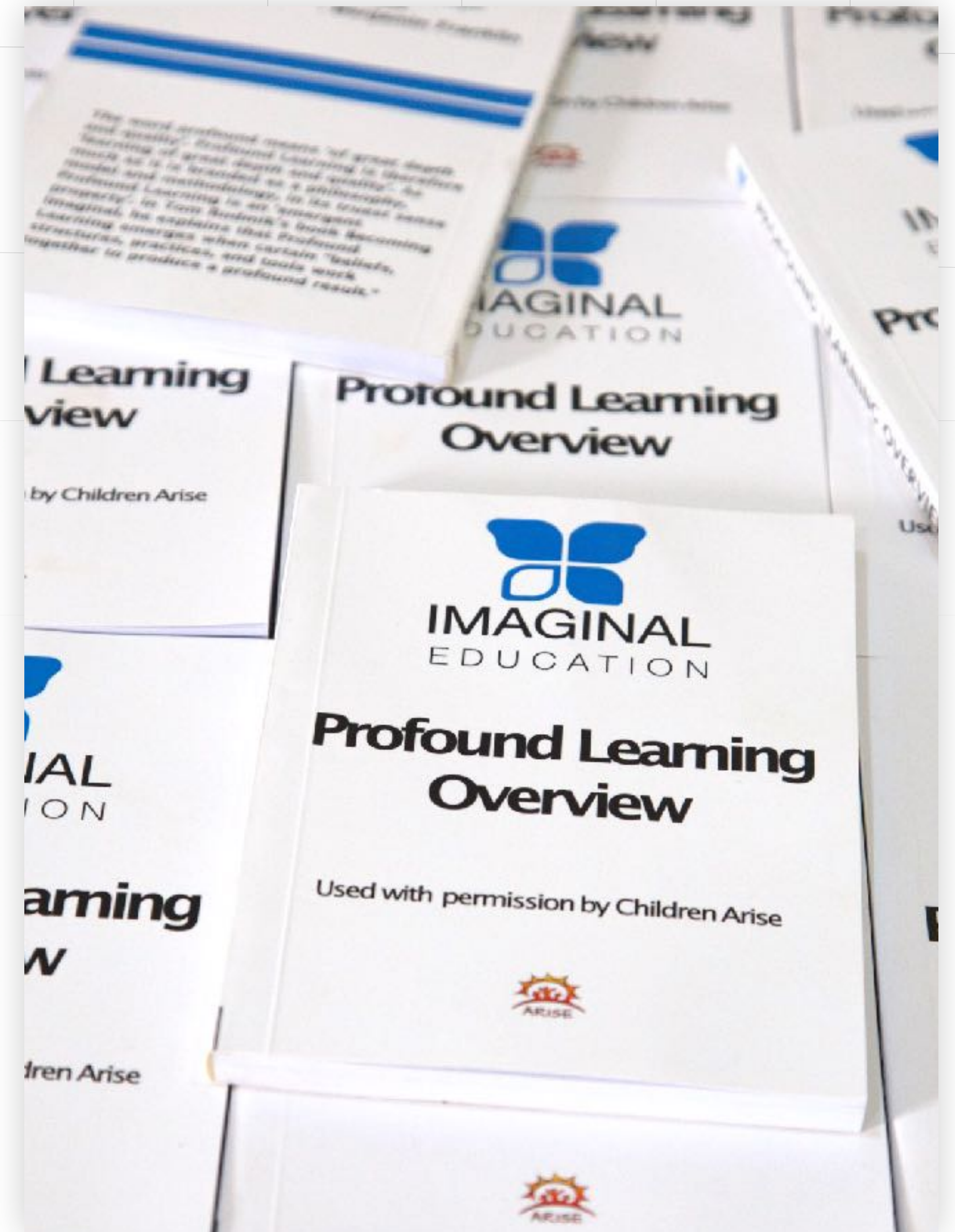
■ ARISE EDUCATION

Arise has been working to bring transformation to the education sector here in Uganda. The Arise Education project aims to introduce 21st century teaching methods. This goal may sound lofty and it is, but several years of groundwork is about to blossom.

Arise has partnered with a large local school called Ebenezer. Ebenezer has 4 locations with about 7000 K-12 students. In August, Arise will launch the transition at 2 of 4 Ebenezer schools by providing 3 workshops focusing on Profound Learning education fundamentals and methods.

It will take years to fully transition Ebenezer schools to Profound Learning and demonstrate the value of engaging children in their education, but this journey is beginning.

To help teachers begin their transformation, Arise will mentor them in classrooms, engage their questions in an online discussion forum, and we have prepared a workbook with details about Profound Learning methods.



■ THE BANMAN'S

Joshua and Grace have begun a new home-schooling program and are moving ahead well with their studies. Joshua has now starting grade 3 while Grace is still completing grade 2.

We switched to an online system called Time4Learning which is very interactive and offers us more help knowing what content needs to be covered.

Terry adds some paper-based exercises to this and also introduces external activities to strengthen their math and spelling skills.

Over time, Terry has learned that she must stay with the kids and direct the learning process. While we thought Terry would be able to work on her own tasks while Joshua and Grace did their work, it was clear quickly that the kids need a full-time guide to help them focus and get through the work.
